









New IG Geometry

- Brazil/ICANN Initiative

Consensus

- Serious crisis in IG
- Undermine trust as the main IG pillar
- Need to find way of the current situation

Sort of Consensus


• There are rules in existing treaties that should be applied (e.g. privacy protection in the Covenant on the Civil & Political Rights)
